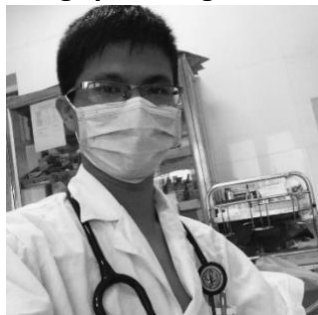


SOS care leavers in frontline team to fight against Corona Virus

Quan grew up from SOS CV Viet Tri, in the northern part of Vietnam. He is now 29 years old, married and working as a doctor at National Hospital of Endocrinology.

Being an excellent doctor of a hospital at national level, above all, Quan is always aware of his responsibilities for the people and community. In his daily work, Quan has been a highly qualified and responsible doctor: attending all the consulting sessions in order to find out the diseases and methods of treatment; taking care of the patients like his

family, etc.

Having acknowledged of the situation from the beginning of Covid-19 outbreak, Quan sent his request to the Department of Health – Hanoi city to join the frontline doctors at National Hospital of Tropical Diseases (one of the first line hospitals to treat all positive cases of Covid-19) and got the approval. In this hospital, together with many other doctors and nurses, Quan has contributed to provide efficient and successful treatment to many infected cases, to do the relevant researches and prevent effectively the spread of corona virus in Vietnam.

In addition to his professional work, Quan also joined the volunteer groups to reach the remote areas where there are many minorities and provided instructions of preventive measures: e.g. wash their hands regularly with soap, wear the masks correctly, and limit gathering, etc. Moreover, with other volunteers, Quan also gave a part of his salary to buy the masks and hand sanitizers for the minorities. He even did health checks for those in need during his visits.

“During his years of work in health sector, this is the first time I have ever seen such dangerous pandemic with a large scope and high speed of infection, high risk of death, causing profound effects to the globe, including Vietnam” shared by Quan from his simple and sincere thought.
