

## Uyanga.G – Care leaver of SOS Ulaanbaatar

Uyanga.G arrived in the Village with her 2 sisters in October, 2002. Her mother is dead and father was unable to care them. She lived in 4<sup>th</sup> family house named as a Aquilegia of Ulaanbaatar SOS SFC for 9 years.

She was talented, diligent and good example for the SOS siblings. She also used to participate in all activities and trainings organized in the Village and she took the first and second places from the competitions when she was in the Village. For example:

- She took a Cup and Certificate from “Devjee” competition organized by Family, Child and Youth Development Department of City & Education TV.
- She participated in “My rights and obligations” competition 4 times with SOS team and took 1<sup>st</sup> place, Gold medal and a Cup organized by Family, Child and Youths’ Development Department of City.
- She also prized with “Talented student” certificate and Gold medal by Family, Child and Youths’ Development Department of City.

She studied in 97<sup>th</sup> general educational school in Bayanzurkh district and she entered in Mongolian National University of Education as a Math teacher in 2009 and graduated in 2013. She left SOS as a self-independently in June, 2011 and now she is living with her father, 2 sisters and a son. After she graduated the university, she got a job in “Bricks for kids” school as a math teacher and she worked there between 2017 and 2018.

She has been working for “Oyunii Tulga” general educational school as a math teacher since 2018. She is teaching mathematic and abacus to around 100 children who study in elementary and secondary school nowadays through online. Online lesson continuous for 40 minutes and 10 to 19 children study at the same time. When she teaches math to 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> grade children, she teaches and explains lessons to children and their parents together. Because online lesson is difficult for little children to study self-



independently through online channel. After the lessons she gives homework to children and takes back homework through online and checks them. She meets with school administration about children’s lessons, grades, other local works and further works in every weeks through online. According to the school plan, she will teach finger math and online math lessons to elementary school children in the next summer for 3 months.

She and her colleagues joined in “Hand washing challenge against for COVID-19” and they danced the “Hand washing” dance. Then they posted a video record into their school online page for improve children’s awareness about COVID-19 pandemic and hand washing steps.



She also taught the abacus to children and 9 of them participated in “Global Cup Abacus and Mental Arithmetic Championship” in United States of America. This competition organized with 4 age groups and around 300 children from more than 10 countries participated. Her prepared 9 children participated successfully and 6 children took first place, 2 children took second place and 1 child took 3<sup>rd</sup> place and the Cups.

After she left SOS, she took following prizes from the university and work. In this:

- “The Best student” of the University in 2012
- “First place” of Teaching skill Olympiad of the University
- “2<sup>nd</sup> place” of table tennis competition of the Work in 2019
